**4. Title** SWAM businesses; standardizes certification program requirements

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

This bill standardizes certification programs for small, women- or minority-owned (SWAM) businesses and requires the Department of Minority Business Enterprise (DMBE) to develop regulations and certification requirements, consistent with prevailing law, for program implementation. The bill frees small, women- or minority-owned businesses that are certified by DMBE from having to obtain additional certifications from localities.

**8. Fiscal implications:** There could be some costs to DBME associated with the provisions of this bill. At the current time, the agency indicates that it can fund such costs from existing resources.
