4. Title Domestic violence victim fund; name change; funding.

5. Summary/Purpose: This legislation proposes to amend and reenact §§ [9.1-116.1](#) and [16.1-69.48:1](#) of the Code of Virginia, changing the name of the fund to the Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim Fund.

6. No Fiscal Impact: See item #8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The final version of this legislation just changes the name of the Virginia Domestic Violence Victim Fund to the Virginia Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim Fund. The previous version of this legislation had increased the fixed fees for a number criminal and traffic convictions by \$2, generating additional revenues of approximately \$86,454 annually in addition to changing the name of the fund. Since the final version of this bill eliminates the fee increases, there is no fiscal impact from the legislation.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Criminal Justice Services, and Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim Advocate organizations and the courts.

10. Technical amendment necessary: None.

11. Other comments: HB234 was incorporated into this legislation.
