- **5.** Summary/Purpose: This legislation proposes to amend and reenact §§ <u>9.1-116.1</u> and <u>16.1-69.48:1</u> of the Code of Virginia, changing the name of the fund to the Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim Fund.
- 6. No Fiscal Impact: See item #8.
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No.
- **8. Fiscal implications:** This legislation changes the name of the Virginia Domestic Violence Victim Fund to the Virginia Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim Fund. The previous version also increased the fixed fees for a number criminal and traffic convictions by \$2, generating additional revenues of approximately \$86,454 annually. The current version eliminates the fee increases thereby removing any fiscal impact from the legislation.
- **9.** Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Criminal Justice Services, and Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim Advocate organizations and the courts.
