<u>Current Accelerated Sales Tax Payment Program</u>

The accelerated sales tax payment program requires registered sales and use tax dealers and direct payment permit holders with taxable sales of \$50 million or greater during the 12-month period beginning July 1, 2005 and ending June 30, 2006, to make a payment equal to 20 percent of the sales and use tax liability due for the previous June. This accelerated payment is due on June 20, 2006. The accelerated sales tax payment program is scheduled to expire on August 1, 2006, making the June 2006 payment the last payment of the program.

Proposal in this Bill

This bill would accelerate the expiration date of the accelerated sales tax payment program from August 1, 2006 to May 1, 2006, in effect, eliminating the June 2006 payment.

This bill contains an emergency enactment clause; therefore, this bill would become effective upon passage.
