5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill limits the dispensing, sale, or distribution of any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any detectable quantity of pseudoephedrine to the owner of a retail establishment or his authorized agent. In addition, any individual who acquires it must produce a valid government-issued photo identification showing the date of birth of the person and sign a written log or receipt showing the date of the transaction, the name of the person, and the amount acquired. Violation of this bill's provisions would constitute a Class 3 misdemeanor with a fine of up to \$500.
