3. **Committee** Privileges and Elections

4. **Title** Elections; voter registration; citizenship status.

5. **Summary/Purpose:** Requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to furnish monthly lists to the State Board of Elections of license applicants who indicate a non-citizen status on their applications, and directs the State Board to forward the information to the general registrars. Non-citizen status constitutes grounds for canceling a person's voter registration.

8. **Fiscal implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles estimates a one time cost for computer systems changes to be about \$73,000. The state Board of Elections indicates that the administrative costs to implement these provisions would be minimal. The expenditures impact reflects changes to the DMV computer system that would be required by the substitute bill.
