Summary/Purpose: Authorizes the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, in consultation with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the State Veterinarian, and representatives of appropriate agriculture agencies and organizations, to promulgate regulations to control and eradicate wildlife diseases and procedures for the condemnation and indemnification of captive wildlife.
