**4. Title: A bill to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-1128 and 46.1129 of the Code of Virginia , relating to extension of vehicle weight limits.**

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

This substitute bill extends the weight limits authorized under § 46.2-1128 by 5% for vehicles registered as Farm Use without a permit or the payment of any fee. It also extends the weight limits an additional 5% under § 46.2-1129. However, this extension applies only to vehicles hauling Virginia-grown forest or farm products, from the place where they are first produced, cut, harvested, or felled to the location where they are first processed.
