4. Title Safety inspections; exemption for certain trucks and vehicle combinations.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Safety inspections; exemption for certain trucks and vehicle combinations. Exempts from the requirement for annual state vehicle safety inspections vehicles that have gross registered weights or gross combination weight ratings of 10,001 pounds or more, provided such vehicles display valid federal certificates of inspection.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: The fiscal impact on the Department of State Police was derived by obtaining from the Division of Motor Vehicles 273,266 vehicles (as of 7-1-05) that would be affected by this legislation. Fees for inspection would range from \$15 to \$50, depending on the size of the vehicle. However, the Department of State Police receives \$.20 per inspection for processing fees. $273,266 \times \$0.20 = \$54,653.20$. This would represent the maximum loss of revenue for the Department; however, it is unknown how many more vehicles this legislation may cause to be registered in Virginia and housed in another state, since the inspection would not be required. For each commercial vehicle registered in Virginia, the Department of State Police receives \$1.00. Therefore, there may be a possibility that the Department would receive more in revenue from the additional \$1.00 fee collected than from the loss of the inspection (\$.20) revenue.
