5. Summary/Purpose: The bill provides that as a condition of licensure as a real estate salesperson or broker, an applicant must have at a minimum a high school diploma or its equivalent.

6. Fiscal Impact: The bill does not have a fiscal impact for the Real Estate Board or the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.
