**4. Title** Board of Pharmacy; specific powers and duties

**5. Summary/Purpose:** Directs the Board of Pharmacy to limit the implementation of their pedigree system to those drugs that have left the normal distribution channel. "Normal distribution channel" is defined as a chain of custody for a prescription drug from initial sale by a pharmaceutical manufacturer, through acquisition and sale by one wholesale distributor, until final sale to a pharmacy or other person dispensing or administering the controlled substance.

**8. Fiscal implications:** The Board of Pharmacy is already required to include the establishment of a pedigree system in its regulations. This legislation would limit the scope of the regulations for the system.
