Summary/Purpose: The bill would require that an application for a new solid waste management facility permit or a modification of a permit to allow an existing solid waste management facility to expand or increase its capacity must include certification from the governing body for the locality in which the facility is or will be located that: (i) the proposed new facility or the expansion or increase in capacity of the existing facility is consistent with the applicable approved local or regional solid waste management plan; or (ii) the local government or solid waste management planning unit has initiated the process to revise the solid waste management plan to include the new or expanded facility. The bill further provides that no application for coverage under a permit-by-rule or for modification of coverage under a permit-by-rule shall be complete unless it contains certification from the governing body of the locality in which the facility is to be located that the facility is consistent with the approved solid waste management plan.
