Increases monthly retirement benefits of future retirees by increasing the percentage of average final compensation multiplied by the amount of creditable service according to the years of service as follows:

- **7. Budget amendment necessary:** Yes. VRS requests an additional appropriation of \$330,000 (NGF) in FY07 if this bill is approved for systems development and communications.
- **8. Fiscal implications:** The *Code of Virginia* requires the VRS to set contribution rates every two years. The costs associated with this bill would accrue in FY07 and would be recognized as an increase in the employer contribution rates beginning in FY09.
- **9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** VRS, state agencies, school systems, local governments that provide special benefits for hazardous duty officers, teachers and localities, State Police, VaLORS.
