4. Title Education; criminal records checks for school volunteers.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that if a local school division, in its discretion, requires fingerprinting or criminal records checks of school volunteers, all associated costs shall be paid by the school division or by the Commonwealth with such funds as may be appropriated for this purpose.

6. No Fiscal Impact.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The legislation does not establish a requirement for fingerprinting or criminal record checks but does provide for the use of state funds as may be appropriated for such purpose. The language also provides for the use of local funds for any costs associated with such requirements. It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact to the state because any locality that chooses to enact such requirements can cover the costs with local funds.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Local school divisions.
