5. Summary/Purpose: The bill authorizes the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to issue a dual applicator license for both pesticide and fertilizer.

6. Fiscal impact: The bill will not decrease the revenue generated through licensing fees or the workload associated with administering the applicator license program.

8. Fiscal implications: The bill provides that the cost of the dual license shall not exceed the combined cost of the pesticide applicator license and the fertilizer applicator permit.
