Summary/Purpose:** This legislation proposes to amend and reenact § [9.1-102](#) of the Code of Virginia to require the Harrisonburg City Police Department and the Rockingham County Sheriff's Office to develop a program to encourage law-enforcement officers to learn languages in addition to English. The legislation specifies that the program is limited to twenty-five participants and that the provisions of the act will expire January 1, 2009.
