4. Title Special Advisory Commission on Mandated Health Insurance Benefits; staffing

5. Summary/Purpose:

Adds the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) to the agencies that must provide staff support to the Special Advisory Commission on Mandated Health Insurance Benefits, (Advisory Commission) along with the Bureau of Insurance and the Health Department. The bill gives JLARC the power to assess, analyze, and evaluate the social and economic costs and benefits of any proposed mandated benefit or provider, including but not limited to the predicted effect on premiums and related costs, net costs or savings to the health care system and other relevant issues and report its findings to the Advisory Commission.
