Authorizes the issuance of three demerit points for the first and subsequent violations of HOV lane restrictions and increases fines for the first, second and third violations.

8. Fiscal implications:

Fines resulting from repeated violations of HOV lane regulations will be doubled from current levels and the addition of three demerit points beyond the first offense. The table below reflects the proposed fine changes.

Offense	Current Fine	Proposed Fine
First Offense	\$50	\$125
Second Offense	\$200	\$250
Third Offense	\$500	\$500
Fourth Offense & subsequent offenses	\$1,000	\$1,000

There is not enough information available to reliably estimate how much additional revenue may be collected from increasing the fines, or if the fine increase would be a deterrent to misuse of the HOV lanes. Any additional fines collected under this provision would be deposited to the Literary Fund.
