**5. Summary/Purpose:** The bill would provide that personal service providers are not eligible for enterprise zone job creation grants. Under current law, local service providers are not eligible for enterprise zone job creation grants.

**6. Fiscal impact:** The bill could impact the allocation of enterprise zone job creation grants, but it would not affect total spending for the grants.
