4. Title Vendor's manual; DGS, et al to establish procedure for refunding relevant eVa transaction fees.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires the Department of General Services (DGS), in cooperation with the Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA), to establish and publish in the vendor's manual a procedure for refunding the relevant eVa transaction fees in the event of a change order or cancellation of a contract by a vendor.

6. Fiscal impact is minimal

8. Fiscal implications: There will be an administrative cost to publish the procedures in the vendor's manual. DGS has already started drafting these procedures and can absorb these costs in its current operating budget. VITA indicates that any cost associated with implementing this bill can be absorbed within its existing budget.
