Summary/Purpose: The bill would provide that an application for a new or modified Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit authorizing discharge of stormwater runoff from a municipal waste landfill or related facility into a local watershed protection district established by ordinance prior to January 1, 2006, shall not be considered complete unless it contains notification and consent from the local governing body of the locality in which the discharge is to take place that the discharge is consistent with the local watershed protection ordinance. This provision would apply to new and modified individual Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits and new and modified coverage under general Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits.
