4. Title Court of Appeals; chief judge; additional compensation.

5. Summary/Purpose: Increases the additional compensation of the chief judge of the Court of Appeals from \$1,000 to \$3,000 per year.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final. See Item 8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: According to the Supreme Court, this legislation increases the salary of the chief judge of the Court of Appeals and will have a general fund fiscal impact of \$2,890 per fiscal year, \$890 of which is to cover the associated increase in fringe benefits. The agency should be able to absorb this cost.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Court system

10. Technical amendment necessary: No

11. Other comments: In their proposed budget, the Senate provided \$5,560 each year to cover the cost of increasing the additional compensation from \$1,000 to \$5,000 each year. This amount is higher than the present fiscal impact of this legislation due to the modifications to the legislation since the Senate budget amendments were made.
