4. Title Emissions inspection program

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill would exempt vehicles manufactured for the current model year or any of the three immediately preceding model years from the requirement to have an emissions test performed at an emissions inspection station, unless the vehicles have been identified by the remote sensing program as violating the emissions standards established for that program.

6. Fiscal impact: There would be no fiscal impact to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) associated with the bill. DEQ does not anticipate any workload reductions associated with the bill. Even though there would be fewer vehicles inspected, there would likely be no reduction in the number of inspection stations, and thus no reduction in DEQ's oversight responsibilities.
