**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Bill authorizes the Interstate Transportation Compact and the related Interstate Transportation Compact Commission to study, coordinate, develop and promote plans, and the legal framework needed to design, construct, finance, or operate interstate transportation projects of strategic interest to those states that sign the Compact, including facilities authorized by the Public-Private Transportation Act (PPTA) of 1995.
