Summary/Purpose:** The bill would require abatement when a child residing in a rental unit is found to have elevated blood-lead levels and to be lead poisoned and would prohibit retaliation; i.e., termination of the rental agreement or an invalid unilateral change in the terms of the rental agreement by landlords when lead risks or the identification of a child found to have elevated blood-lead levels and to be lead poisoned is reported.
