4. Title Line of Duty Act

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill would provide that any disabled state employee included in the definition of a deceased person under the Line of Duty Act, regardless of the date of disability, would be entitled to receive health insurance coverage fully paid for by the Commonwealth on a prospective basis on or after July 1, 2006. (Under current law, any eligible person disabled on or after July 1, 2000, and any eligible state employee disabled on or after January 1, 1972, is entitled to receive health insurance coverage fully paid for by the Commonwealth.)

6. Fiscal impact: DPB cannot estimate the fiscal impact associated with this bill. The fiscal impact would depend on a number of factors, including the number of eligible state employees disabled before January 1, 1972, the number of such individuals who file claims, and the costs associated with health insurance coverage.
