5. Summary/Purpose:

Adds the Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry to the membership of the Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission and the Virginia Land Conservation Board of Trustees. The bill also removes the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services from the Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission.

8. Fiscal implications: Increasing the membership of the Virginia Land Conservation Board of Trustees may increase expenditures. However, any impact is expected to be nominal and can be absorbed within existing resources.
