4. Title Composition of Board of Game and Inland Fisheries.

5. Summary/Purpose:

The bill requires the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to ensure that the Auditor of Public Accounts (APA), or an entity approved by the APA, conducts an annual audit of the department's financial records. The bill also requires that (i) the minute books and other records of the agency be open to examination by members of the General Assembly and (ii) the appointment of the Director of the department be subject to confirmation by the General Assembly.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: Any fiscal impact is expected to be negligible and can be absorbed within current resources.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Auditor of Public Accounts

11. Other comments: This version of the bill is a compilation of HB 938, HB 979, HB 1130, and HB1131. Also, the companion bill is HB362, which is also enrolled.
