3. Committee General Laws

4. Title Department of General Services; Division of Purchases and Supply; purchases by private nonprofit.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Allows private, nonprofit institutions of higher education chartered in Virginia to purchase directly from state contracts established by the Department of General Services' (DGS) Division of Purchases and Supply.

6. Fiscal impact cannot be determined. See Item 8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: Under this proposal, the Division of Purchases and Supply in DGS would have to modify existing statewide contracts to include the private, nonprofit institutions of higher education chartered in Virginia. There will be some additional administrative costs to DGS. Because of the increased purchasing volume, the statewide contracts may result in better leveraged pricing and greater savings across the Commonwealth. The administrative costs and the potential savings cannot be determined.
