4. **Title** Hunters for the Hungry donations.

5. **Summary/Purpose:** Increases the cost of the resident big game license by \$1 and the nonresident big game license by \$2. The amount of the increases will be allocated to the Hunters for the Hungry.

7. **Budget amendment necessary:** No.

8. **Fiscal implications:** The legislation would generate an additional \$258,000 in annual revenue for the Hunter for the Hungry; the agency currently sells 226,000 big game licenses to residents and 16,000 nonresidents.

The legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the agency, as Game and Inland Fisheries' licensing agents currently accept voluntary donations for Hunters for the Hungry, as provided for in subsection A of §29.1-305, Code of Virginia. Any revenue generated from the voluntary contributions and the enhanced fee is deposited to a special fund, the Feed the Hungry Fund, within Game.
