**3. Committee:** Transportation

- **4. Title:** Relating to matching and revenue-sharing funds for highways in certain counties, cities, and towns.
- **5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill repeals the existing transportation revenue sharing program and replaces it with a larger revenue sharing program available to all cities, counties, and towns. It increases the state matching funds to \$1 million and establishes the priority order for the allocation of the matching funds. It establishes the program size at \$50 million in transportation revenues.
- 6. Fiscal impact estimates are final.
