4. Title Frequency of school fire drills during Standards of Learning assessments

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill would require the Board of Housing and Community Development to promulgate regulations to prohibit fire and evacuation drills from being conducted in schools during periods of mandatory testing required by the Board of Education. The bill includes an enactment clause requiring the promulgation of emergency regulations.

6. Fiscal impact: There would be some costs to the Department of Housing and Community Development associated with the adoption of the new regulations. However, such costs could be funded from existing resources.
