citizens of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, Larry Gallaher is recognized for his career as New Kent County's emergency
 management coordinator, hazardous materials coordinator, and for his many years of dedication to

WHEREAS, Larry Gallaher moved to his beloved New Kent County in 1976 and joined the New
 Kent County Volunteer Fire Department as a volunteer firefighter; and
