Requires legislative authorization from the General Assembly to transfer the responsibility for control, maintenance, and/or operation of any toll facility from the Virginia Department of Transportation to any other public or private entity.

- **8. Fiscal implications:** Under the current provisions of the Public Private Transportation Act of 1995, unsolicited proposals can be accepted by VDOT and toll facilities are not excluded. Transferring approval to the General Assembly would slow the decision making process and could lead to missed opportunities for Public Private Partnerships for these facilities because the General Assembly meets annually. The established timeline for completion of the PPTA process is not compatible with the requirement to secure General Assembly approval of all transfers.
