CHAPTER 310

An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-1307 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the designation of private roads as highways.

Approved March 12, 2007

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-1307 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-1307. Designation of private roads as highways for law-enforcement purposes.

The governing body of any county, city, or town may adopt ordinances designating the private roads, within any residential development containing 100 or more lots *or residential dwelling units*, as highways for law-enforcement purposes.
