An Act to amend and reenact § 19.2-163.3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the duties of public defenders.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 19.2-163.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 19.2-163.3. Duties of public defenders.

Public defenders and their assistants shall carry out the following duties in accordance with the guidance, policies, and authorizations of the Indigent Defense Commission:

- (a) To secure assist the executive director of the Commission in securing office space, to employ a staff, to fix salaries and to do such other things necessary to carry out the duties imposed upon them with the approval of the Commission.
- (b) To represent or supervise assistants in representing within their respective jurisdictions as set out in § 19.2-163.04 indigent persons charged with a crime or offense when such persons are entitled to be represented by law by court-appointed counsel in a court of record or a court not of record.
- (c) To represent or supervise assistants in representing indigent persons who are entitled to be represented by court-appointed counsel in an appeal of their conviction to the Court of Appeals or the Supreme Court of Virginia.
 - (d) To represent indigent prisoners when a habeas corpus proceeding is brought by such prisoners.
 - (e) To submit such reports as required by the Commission.
