6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 24.2-231 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 24.2-231. Forfeiture of office by person sentenced for commission of certain crimes.

9 Any person holding any public office of honor, profit, or trust in this Commonwealth who is
10 convicted of a felony *or any offense for which registration is required as defined in § 9.1-902* and for
11 whom all rights of appeal ~~have terminated~~ *under Virginia law have expired*, shall by such final
12 conviction forfeit his office or post and thereafter may not act therein under his previous election or
13 appointment. A pardon which may be afterwards granted him shall not void the forfeiture.
