9	[ WHEREAS, on the barrier islands of Virginia and North Carolina, there exists a herd of wild
10	horses that are the last known herd of Spanish mustangs existing in a natural state and whose presence
11	predates English settlement in North America; and
12	WHEREAS, in 1929, a reporter for National Geographic magazine noted that more than 5,000 wild
13	horses roamed the coasts of Virginia and North Carolina; and
14	WHEREAS, a portion of the Outer Banks north of Corolla and south of the Virginia state line has
15	been designated as a wild horse sanctuary; and
16	WHEREAS, horses leaving the wild horse sanctuary risk entering Virginia and being killed on the
17	roadways and entering populated areas near Virginia Beach; and
18	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth must protect the presence of this important cultural and historical
19	resource in Virginia, which is an emblem of our national heritage; and
20	WHEREAS, there is a need for funds for the construction of fences to contain the horses safely in

	the wild horse sanctuary, for assisting community groups willing to return horses to the sanctuary from
22	populated areas in Virginia, and for paying for the medical care needed by horses injured on Virginia
23	roadways; now, therefore, ]
24	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
25	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Subtitle I of Title 10.1 a chapter numbered
26	10.3, consisting of a section numbered 10.1-1027, as follows:
27	CHAPTER 10.3.
28	WILD SPANISH MUSTANGS FUND.
29	§ 10.1-1027. Wild Spanish Mustangs Fund established; administration; purpose.
30	There is hereby established in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the Wild
31	Spanish Mustangs Fund, hereafter referred to as the Fund. The Fund shall consist of such moneys as
32	may be appropriated by the General Assembly and such other moneys as may be made available from
33	any other source, public or private. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund
34	and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each
35	fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund, but shall remain in the Fund. The Fund shall be
36	administered by the Department of Conservation and Recreation. Any expenditure from the Fund shall
37	be subject to the recommendations of the Park Manager at False Cape State Park, with advice and
38	consultation from the City of Virginia Beach, local legislators, and interested community members. The
<b>39</b>	Fund shall be used for the general purpose of protecting the herd of wild Spanish mustangs on the
<b>40</b>	barrier islands of Virginia. Allocations may include, but are not limited to, the erection and
