2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 29.1-328 of the Code of Virginia, relating to a change in the term of*  
3 *National Forest Stamps.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 29.1-328 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 29.1-328. Term of licenses and permits.

9 A. Until the Department has implemented an automated point-of-sale licensing system, hunting and  
10 trapping licenses and permits, including those issued pursuant to § 29.1-302, shall be valid from July 1  
11 of each year or their later date of purchase, to June 30 of the following year, unless sooner revoked.  
12 Upon implementation of such a system, hunting and trapping licenses and permits shall be valid for one  
13 year from their date of purchase, except those licenses issued pursuant to § 29.1-305, which shall be  
14 valid from July 1 of each year or their later date of purchase, to June 30 of the following year, unless  
15 sooner revoked.

16 B. Until the Department has implemented an automated point-of-sale licensing system, fishing  
17 licenses shall run and be valid from January 1 of each year or their later date of purchase to December  
18 31 of same year, unless sooner revoked. Upon implementation of such a system, fishing licenses shall  
19 run and be valid for one year from their date of purchase.

20 C. The terms of licenses listed in subsections A and B of this section shall not apply to the lifetime  
21 hunting and fishing license established in § 29.1-302.1.

22 D. National Forest Stamps, issued pursuant to § 29.1-408, shall be valid ~~from January 1 of each year~~  
23 ~~or their later date of purchase, to December 31 of the same year or from July 1 of each year or their~~  
24 ~~later date of purchase, to June 30 of the following year~~ *for one year from their date of purchase*, unless  
25 sooner revoked.
