6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 2.2-212 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 2.2-212. Position established; agencies for which responsible; additional powers.

9 The position of Secretary of Health and Human Resources (the Secretary) is created. The Secretary
10 of Health and Human Resources shall be responsible to the Governor for the following agencies:
11 Department of Health, Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired, Department of Health Professions,
12 Department for the Aging, Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse
13 Services, Department of Rehabilitative Services, Department of Social Services, Department of Medical
14 Assistance Services, Child Day-Care Council, Virginia Department for the Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing,
15 the Office of Comprehensive Services for Youth and At-Risk Youth and Families, and the Assistive
16 Technology Loan Fund Authority. The Governor may, by executive order, assign any other state
17 executive agency to the Secretary of Health and Human Resources, or reassign any agency listed above
18 to another Secretary.

19 Unless the Governor expressly reserves such power to himself, the Secretary shall (i) ~~coordinate the~~
20 ~~work of state agencies to implement the long-term care policy of the Commonwealth~~ *serve as the lead*
21 *Secretary for the coordination and implementation of the long-term care policy of the Commonwealth,*
22 *working with the Secretaries of Transportation, Commerce and Trade, and Education, and the*
23 *Commissioner of Insurance, to facilitate interagency service development and implementation,*
24 *communication and cooperation* and (ii) serve as the lead Secretary for the Comprehensive Services Act
25 for At-Risk Youth and Families, working with the Secretary of Education and the Secretary of Public
26 Safety to facilitate interagency service development and implementation, communication and
27 cooperation.
