14	of existing streets and to widen or narrow, lay out and graduate, pave and otherwise improve streets and
15	public highways within said town, to remove obstructions therefrom, and shall also have the power to
16	pass and enforce all by-laws, rules, regulations and ordinances which the town council may deem
