2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 15.2-5204 of the Code of Virginia, relating to members of hospital or*
3 *health center commissions.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 15.2-5204 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 15.2-5204. Members of commission; quorum; compensation; expenses; removal and vacancies.

9 A hospital or health center commission shall consist of the following number of members based upon
10 the number of political subdivisions participating: for one political subdivision, five members; for two,
11 six members; for three, six members; for four, eight members; and for more than four, one member for
12 each of the participating subdivisions. The respective members shall be appointed by the governing
13 bodies of the subdivisions they represent, may be members of such governing bodies, ~~shall~~ *may* be
14 residents of such subdivisions, and shall be appointed for such terms as the appointing body designates.
15 A member shall hold office until the earlier of the effective date of his resignation or the date on which
16 his successor has been appointed and has qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. The
17 powers of the commission conferred by this chapter shall be vested in and exercised by the members in
18 office. A majority of the members then in office shall constitute a quorum. The commission shall elect
19 its own chairman and shall adopt rules and regulations for its own procedure and government. The
20 commission members may receive up to \$50 for attendance at each commission meeting, not to exceed
21 \$1,200 per year, and shall be paid their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Any
22 commission member may be removed at any time by the governing body appointing him, and vacancies
23 on the commission shall be filled for the unexpired terms.

24 In any county having a population between 200,000 and 215,000, the number of commission
25 members shall be seven and their terms may be staggered as the appointing body designates.
