072561380 **HOUSE BILL NO. 2308** 1 2 3 4 5 6 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources on January 17, 2007) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Lingamfelter) A BILL to amend and reenact § 29.1-528 of the Code of Virginia, relating to establishing model 7 ordinances for hunting with firearms. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 9 1. That § 29.1-528 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 29.1-528. Board to develop model ordinances for hunting with firearms; counties or cities may 11 adopt. 12 A. The Board shall promulgate regulations establishing model ordinances for hunting with firearms that may be adopted by counties or cities. Such model ordinances developed by the Board shall address 13 such items as, but are not limited to, firearm caliber, type of firearm (e.g., rifle, shotgun, muzzleloader), 14 and type of ammunition. The governing body of any county or city may, by ordinance, prohibit hunting 15 in such county or city with a shotgun loaded with slugs, or with a rifle of a caliber larger than .22 16 rimfire. However, such ordinance may permit the hunting of groundhogs with a rifle of a caliber larger 17 than .22 rimfire between March 1 and August 31. Such ordinance may also permit the use of 18 muzzle-loading rifles during the prescribed open seasons for the hunting of game species. Any such 19 20 ordinance may also specify permissible type of ammunition to be used for such hunting. 21 B. No such ordinance shall be enforceable unless the governing body notifies the Director by 22 registered mail prior to May 1 of the year in which the ordinance is to take effect. 23 C. In adopting an ordinance pursuant to the provisions of this section the governing body of any 24 county or city may provide that any person who violates the provisions of the ordinance shall be guilty

25 of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
