Larceny of a dog collar; penalty. 12 13 Any person who commits the larceny of an electronic, radio transmitting, or other collar from a dog 14 is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor; however, if the animal wearing the collar is lost or killed as a result of the collar theft, the person is guilty of a Class 5 felony. Upon a finding of guilt, the court shall 15 order that the defendant pay \$1,000 restitution for any dog lost or killed, or greater proven actual 16 damages. Such proven actual damages may include training expenses and lost breeding revenues. 17 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 18 19 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot 20 be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for 21 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
