6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-97.1, relating to malicious
7	removal of a dog collar; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-97.1 as follows:
10	§ 18.2-97.1. Malicious removal of a dog collar; penalty.
11	Any person who, with malicious intent, removes an electronic radio transmitting collar from a dog is
12	guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor; however, if the animal wearing the collar is lost or killed as a result
13	of the collar removal, the person is guilty of a Class 6 felony.
14	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
15	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
16	be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for

17 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
