# 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 7 1. That § 55-548.10 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
- **8** § 55-548.10. Recordkeeping and identification of trust property.
- 9 A. A trustee shall keep adequate records of the administration of the trust.
- 10 B. A trustee shall keep trust property separate from the trustee's own property.

11 C. Except as otherwise provided in subsection D, a trustee shall cause the trust property to be 12 designated so that the interest of the trust, to the extent feasible, appears in records maintained by a 13 party other than a trustee or beneficiary.

- 14 D. If the trustee maintains records clearly indicating the respective interests, a trustee may invest as a 15 whole the property of two or more separate trusts.
- 16 E. A deed or other instrument purporting to convey or transfer real or personal property to a trust
- 17 instead of to the trustee or trustees of the trust shall be deemed to convey or transfer such property to
- 18 the trustee or trustees as fully as if made directly to the trustee or trustees.
