That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-295.1 as follows: 10 § 18.2-295.1. Certification of the transfer and registration of weapons subject to the National 11 Firearms Act. 12 The Superintendent of the Department of State Police shall be deemed a chief law-enforcement 13 officer in the Commonwealth for purposes of certification of the transfer and registration of weapons 14 required to be certified pursuant to the National Firearms Act, 26 USC Chapter 53. 15 When the certification of the chief law-enforcement officer is required by federal law for certification of the transfer and registration of weapons, the Superintendent of State Police or his designee shall 16 provide such certification within 15 days of receipt of the federal application and the request for 17 certification, so long as the Superintendent does not have any information that the applicant is 18 prohibited by law from receiving the firearm. 19
