Prohibition against concealment of dead body; penalty.  Any person who transports, secretes, conceals, desecrates or alters a dead body, as defined in § 32.1-249, with the intent to prevent detection of the death or the manner or cause of death is guilty of a Class 6 felony.  2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
