4 *requirements for professional wetland delineator certification.*

7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**8 **1. That § 54.1-2206.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

9 § 54.1-2206.2. Requirements for professional wetland delineator certification.

10 A. In order to be certified as a professional wetland delineator, an applicant shall achieve a score
11 acceptable to the Board on an examination, which may include a field practicum, in the principles and
12 practice of wetland delineation, provide three written references from wetland professionals with at least
13 one from a certified professional wetland delineator, and satisfy one of the following criteria:

14 1. Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution of higher education in a wetland science,
15 biology, biological engineering, civil and environmental engineering, ecology, soil science, geology,
16 hydrology or any similar biological, physical, natural science or environmental engineering curriculum
17 that has been approved by the Board; have successfully completed a course of instruction, in state and
18 federal wetland delineation methods, that has been approved by the Board; and have at least four years
19 of experience in wetland delineation under the supervision of a certified professional wetland delineator,
20 the quality of which demonstrates to the Board that the applicant is competent to practice as a certified
21 professional wetland delineator;

22 2. Have a record of at least six years of experience in wetland delineation under the supervision of a
23 certified professional wetland delineator, the quality of which demonstrates to the Board that the
24 applicant is competent to practice as a certified professional wetland delineator; or

25 3. Have a record of at least four years of experience in wetland science research or as a teacher of
26 wetlands curriculum in an accredited institution of higher education, the quality of which demonstrates
27 to the Board that the applicant is competent to practice as a certified professional wetland delineator.

28 B. Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection A, the requirement for a reference from and
29 supervision by a certified professional wetland delineator shall be waived for the first ~~two~~ six years of
30 the program.

31 **2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.**
