

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-332 of the Code of Virginia, relating to fees associated with*  
3 *examination of applicants for commercial driver's licenses.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-332 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-332. Fees.

9 On and after January 1, 1990, the fee for each driver's license other than a commercial driver's  
10 license shall be two dollars and forty cents per year. If the license is a commercial driver's license or  
11 seasonal restricted commercial driver's license, the fee shall be six dollars per year. Persons twenty-one  
12 years old or older may be issued a scenic driver's license, learner's permit, or commercial driver's license  
13 for an additional fee of five dollars. For any one or more driver's license endorsements, except a  
14 motorcycle endorsement, there shall be an additional fee of one dollar per year; for a motorcycle  
15 endorsement, there shall be an additional fee of two dollars per year. For any and all driver's license  
16 classifications, there shall be an additional fee of one dollar per year. For any revalidation of a seasonal  
17 restricted commercial driver's license, the fee shall be five dollars.

18 A reexamination fee of two dollars shall be charged for each administration of the knowledge portion  
19 of the driver's license examination taken by an applicant who is eighteen years of age or older if taken  
20 more than once within a fifteen-day period. The reexamination fee shall be charged each time the  
21 examination is administered until the applicant successfully completes the examination, if taken prior to  
22 the fifteenth day.

23 An applicant who is less than eighteen years of age who does not successfully complete the  
24 knowledge portion of the driver's license examination shall not be permitted to take the knowledge  
25 portion more than once in fifteen days.

26 *A fee of \$50 shall be charged each time an applicant for a commercial driver's license fails to keep*  
27 *a scheduled skills test appointment, unless such applicant cancels his appointment with the assigned*  
28 *driver's license examiner at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled appointment. The Commissioner*  
29 *may, on a case-by-case basis, waive such fee for good cause shown. All such fees shall be paid by the*  
30 *Commissioner into the state treasury and set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the necessary*  
31 *expenses incurred by the Department.*

32 If the applicant for a driver's license is an employee of the Commonwealth, or of any county, city, or  
33 town who drives a motorcycle or a commercial motor vehicle solely in the line of his duty, he shall be  
34 exempt from the additional fee otherwise assessable for a motorcycle classification or a commercial  
35 motor vehicle endorsement. The Commissioner may prescribe the forms as may be requisite for  
36 completion by persons claiming exemption from additional fees imposed by this section.

37 No additional fee above two dollars and forty cents per year shall be assessed for the driver's license  
38 or commercial driver's license required for the operation of a school bus.

39 Excluding the two-dollar reexamination fee, one dollar and fifty cents of all fees collected for each  
40 original or renewal driver's license shall be paid into the driver education fund of the state treasury and  
41 expended as provided by law. Unexpended funds from the driver education fund shall be retained in the  
42 fund and be available for expenditure in ensuing years as provided therein.

43 All fees for motorcycle endorsements shall be distributed as provided in § 46.2-1191.

44 This section shall supersede conflicting provisions of this chapter.
